Pay Authorisation fees within sixty (60) days from the date of issue of Provisional Authorisation.

Receive Final Authorisation and carefully READ the Conditions of Final Authorisation.

Set up your TV Station(s)
within two (2) years from the
date of issue of Final
Authorisation. Failure to do so
will result in penalties ranging
from a fine to revocation.

Invite NCA for inspection after completing the set up of your TV Station(s). Refer to inspection checklist on the next page for guidance.

TV INSPECTION Checklist

- Content production and playout equipment properly installed.
- Programs / Visitors logbook.
- List of all installed equipment with data sheet of transmission system.
- Where applicable, establish transmission link to multiplex provider.
- Where applicable, Studio should be acoustically treated and door adequately secured.
- Availability of reliable backup power source.
- Valid Fire Certificate and visible installation of fire extinguishers at vantage points.
- Security post or desk with personnel for duration of station's daily broadcast.











TV INSPECTION Checklist

- Adequate ventilation/cooling for studio and equipment.
- Signage / Signboard/Physical marking of station for identification.
- On-Air light installed at entrance of Studio where applicable.
- Mast/Tower(s) appropriately painted and properly earthed.
- Aviation obstruction light(s) appropriately installed on mast/tower where applicable.
- Permit from EPA approving
 Mast/Tower installation where
 applicable.
- Lightening arrestor installed on mast / tower where applicable.

Wait to receive a Test Transmission Authorisation which shall be issued upon successful inspection.

DTT operators should make programmes available to multiplex provider/headend in the prescribed format and bit rate and with the requisite programming information for the generation of the Electronic Programming Guide (EPG)









7

Settle Annual Regulatory Fees on or before the anniversary date of Final Authorisation.









8

Seek approval from the NCA before making any changes to the Station's ownership, name, location and technical specifications.









9

Apply for renewal of
Authorisation three (3) months
prior to its expiry. The
Authorisation is for a period of
five (5) years and is subject to
renewal upon expiry.
