NCA WELCOMES 2018/2019 NATIONAL SERVICE PERSONNEL

The National Communications Authority (NCA) on 10th September, 2018, held a welcome orientation for 121 National Service Personnel (NSP) of the 2018/2019 service year at the NCA Tower in Accra. The orientation also marked the official launch of a 3-week Boot Camp for the personnel.

Speaking to the NSP, Mr. Charles Amoah-Wilson, Acting Head for Human Resource, deemed it a pleasure for the 2018/2019 batch to join the Authority. He made reference to the previous year's official opening which was graced by Vice President of the Republic of Ghana and other dignitaries.

Touching briefly on the National Service programme and its objectives, Mr. Amoah-Wilson said the programme is a compulsory one-year service required of all citizens of Ghana, who successfully complete their tertiary education; to deploy their energies by offering some service to organizations and communities in any part of the country. He continued that the NCA, therefore, has accepted graduates from thirty-three (33) tertiary institutions across the country for the 2018/2019 service year who will be posted to the various Divisions of the Authority.
